Veterinary health examination must be a continuous procedure that ensures both animal and human health. Farmers who have limited access to such health screenings are more prone to overlook minor ailments that might later develop into a production failure. Similarly, when reproductive efficiency declines, veterinarians, artificial insemination technicians, feed scientists, and other resource personnel are required to analyze the problems and come up with suitable field-oriented remedies.

Apart from boosting the output of milch animals, infertility treatment and control has a human concern. Infertility costs farmers money since it delays maturity, calving, and milk production, and most infections that cause abortions in cattle are zoonotic.

In light of this, on 26.2.2022, Hurricane Vets Charitable Trust, Chennai, in collaboration with the Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of National Capital Territory, New Delhi conducted a free veterinary health and infertility treatment camp at SDMC Primary School, Bhatti Village, South District, New Delhi. This animal health check-up and infertility camps benefitted around 100 animals. Young animals were dewormed, and dogs were given anti-rabies vaccinations. To boost up animals' body nutritional status and general health, the farmers were instructed to undertake routine deworming and vaccinations, as well as providing additional mineral-vitamin mixtures.
