Veterinary health camps play a crucial role in boosting milk production in rural areas by improving the overall health of livestock. These camps provide essential veterinary services like disease prevention, vaccination, deworming, and nutritional counselling for dairy animals. Healthy animals are more productive, leading to higher milk yields. Additionally, farmers receive valuable guidance on breeding practices, hygiene, and proper feeding, which enhances milk quality. By addressing common health issues and promoting better animal care, veterinary health camps significantly contribute to the economic well-being of rural communities, helping farmers improve both milk quantity and quality.

On March 1st, 2025, a free Veterinary Health Camp was organized at S.Ogaiyur village of Kallakurichi District by Thirumala Milk Products Pvt. Ltd. in collaboration with Hurricane Vets Charitable Trust (HVCT), Chennai .



A total of 238 animals were treated, including 93 milch animals, 39 dry animals, 45 heifers, 40 calves, and 21 goats. The team offered a variety of services, such as ecto-parasite control through spraying, pregnancy diagnosis, artificial insemination, and deworming. Ecto-parasite infestations in dairy cattle, caused by external parasites like ticks, lice, and mites was very prominent almost in all the animals. This will lead to reduced milk production, skin irritation, and overall health deterioration. Hence, external sprays were used to eliminate these parasites effectively, enhancing animal health, milk production, and preventing disease spread. The farmers' questions were addressed thoroughly by our professional team, who received high praise for their services.
